Dear Shepherd of the Mountains Family and Friends,

The Columbarium Committee has been working diligently to complete this project which has been in the works for a number of years. A contract to build the vault has been approved by Council, signed, and partial payment has been made. A number of niches have been sold and loved ones' cremains will be interred. Others have purchased niches for their personal use sometime in the future.

We humbly and prayerfully ask that you consider a niche for a final resting place. If you have other plans, we understand. In lieu of considering a niche, would you consider a donation in memory of a loved one, or to help us along with the final completion of this project? Several individuals have anonymously pledged to pay for the stone work around the columbarium vault. With this in mind, we have approximately \$9000 to pay off to complete the contract, due upon the delivery of the vault in December.

While it may be possible to borrow the remaining monies, we would prefer to finish this project once and for all. Keep in mind that Good Samaritan residents, as well as SMLC folks and their loved ones may purchase a slot. Monies collected over and above the initial cost will be retained in the Columbarium Fund for our church. This will take care of any future repairs, upkeep, and landscaping needs, etc.
